

WHAT GOD HAS JOINED TOGETHER

A JOURNEY OF FAITH, RESILIENCE, AND RENEWAL

In 2005, after seasons of challenge and prayerful discernment, Wesley United Methodist Church and Church of Hope UMC joined together to form Wesley Church of Hope UMC — a union approved by the West Ohio Conference and joyfully celebrated on July 3, 2005, under the leadership of Pastor Mamie Jenkins. That day truly felt like "a marriage made in heaven," marking a new beginning for two faithful congregations who became one family in Christ.

Over the past two decades, Wesley Church of Hope has been shepherded by seven pastors, each bringing unique gifts to guide our ministry. Through their leadership — and the faithfulness of our members — worship attendance grew, new ministries were formed, and lives were changed. Music and praise have always been at the heart of our worship, from the youth and senior choirs to the gospel and praise teams. Our fellowship has reached beyond our walls through nursing home ministry, children's sermons, Bible studies, and audio ministry.

Outreach has been a cornerstone of our calling. Partnering with Southside Hope CDC, the church has hosted summer camps for children, distributed coats, shoes, and fresh produce to hundreds of families, and supported Watkins Elementary School through mentorship and community service. Wesley has also helped keep our neighborhood clean, provided blessing bags to the unhoused, and served meals at local shelters — continuing the legacy of love begun by our elders.

When COVID-19 forced churches to close in 2020, Wesley Church of Hope did not lose faith. Led by Lady Merissa and Pastor Charles Ferguson, members gathered safely for outdoor prayer, continued worship online, and even celebrated communion and baptisms virtually. The only thing COVID did was bring us closer together.

As the world reopened, God continued to guide our steps through new seasons of leadership.





Pastor Theresa Wallington-Tipton encouraged each member to "Have a Personal Relationship with God," and the congregation embraced lay leadership and shared ministry. When Pastor Richard Dunbar returned to lead Wesley, he strengthened the church's foundation and oversaw key improvements to the building — even as he battled illness with unshakable faith and love for his flock. Before his passing in June 2025, Pastor Dunbar's greatest joy was seeing the church continue its mission and welcome new leadership.

On July 1, 2025, Pastor Vaughn Cook was appointed as our new shepherd. His dynamic spirit, pastoral care, and connection with young people have breathed fresh energy into our ministry. In these few short months, hearts have been renewed, new baptisms have taken place, and our church family continues to grow.

Through every trial and triumph, Wesley Church of Hope remains what its name declares — a church built on hope, joined together by God, and steadfast in sharing His love with all.

Our story of faith and unity, however, began long before 2005. The roots of Wesley Church of Hope reach back more than a century — to believers who gathered in homes, prayed in faith, and built the foundations upon which we now stand. Their story reminds us that from many, God made us one.
